

Morioka-jo-ato Koen Castle Site Park

Former Nambu Morioka Castle is one of the three great castles in the Tohoku region, along with Aizuwakamatsu Castle and Shirakawa Komine Castle. Nagamasa Asano instructed the construction of the castle, and the construction period began with Nambu Naganao's generation and lasted 40 years until Shigenao's generation. Based on southern-western Japan's masonry technology, they made full use of Nozura, random stacking, cloth stacking, etc. The rich granite of the castle grounds, the Nakatsu-gawa River and the Kitakami-gawa River were used as natural trenches, and the castle was built on a natural fortress. You may also like visiting the rare Ishigaki-bugyo—construction magistrates' stones and the footsteps of Takuboku Ishikawa, a national poet.


